

A.16 Administrative Policy on Voting Procedures

The WVA Statutes and By-Laws state the rules for nominations and the rules for voting.

The WVA Statutes and By-Laws, however, do not state procedures for voting when the number of nominees equals the number of candidates or officers needed.

The Presidents= Assembly has decided that:

1. Where the number of nominees equals the number of officers needed in the specific election there shall be no vote. The nominees shall be deemed elected without voting procedure, but with acclamation.
2. Where there are no nominees for a group for the election of Councillors and the group only consists of the number of officers needed, the members of the PA from the group shall be elected Councillors automatically without nomination and election procedure.
