

A.8 Representative (Delegate) Policy

Those appointed to represent the WVA at international organizations must act as ambassadors of the WVA and report back to the President of the WVA as arranged when appointed. (EXCOM 24 February 1998)

Guidelines

Representatives of the World Veterinary Association must ensure that they receive advice from the President of the WVA, before attending meetings of international organizations.

Permanent or Ad Hoc Representatives must submit a brief report in writing to the Executive Committee of the WVA within 30 days after attending meetings of international organizations.

Permanent WVA Representatives must report on the international organizations at least once each year to the Executive Committee of the WVA. This written report should be received at the latest one month before the annual meeting of the WVA Council. In the case where there has been no activity, this fact should still be reported.
