

A.2 Guidelines for organizations wanting to run a Congress under the auspices of the WVA

Policy

Organizations associated with the World Veterinary Association may conduct a Congress under the auspices of the World Veterinary Association only after having received the specific approval of the WVA Executive Committee.

Explanation

While the WVA encourages its members to conduct congresses on a National and Regional basis, the WVA must be assured that the reputation of the WVA is not damaged and that no liability is imposed on the WVA from any congress failure.

Guidelines

Application must be made directly to the WVA Secretariat and this will be submitted to the WVA Executive Committee.

Applications must contain:

full details of the plans for the Congress including the names of the organizing member(s), the time and place of the congress and the expected number of participants;

and

a financial plan.

The WVA Secretariat will confirm in writing the conditions of the approval which are to be countersigned by the applicant.
