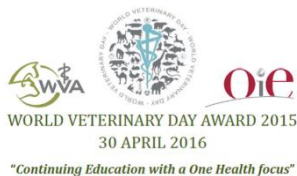

In the light of the World Rabies Day that was celebrated on 28th September 2015, the WVA adopted a new statement on Rabies. The WVA holds that rabies is a vaccine-preventable disease and is committed to eliminating dog-mediated human rabies. Long term programs for dog rabies control include vaccination, community-wide dog spay/neuter programs, as well as focused public awareness and educational programs on rabies prevention and responsible pet ownership.
